


MTB TRAILS MAINTENANCE

Paarl Trails is currently doing cleaning and maintenance on sections of trail in Pearl Valley, after completing similar work on the Val de Vie trails. They take pride in ensuring excellent trail conditions for riders. As a precautionary measure, certain single-track sections have been closed while the maintenance team is at work.

The map below shows the different trail routes in the Greater Estate:

Red route: 23kmBlue route: 11km

• Green route: 5km - The trail has been temporarily re-routed using whiteboards and red arrows, with markers placed along the green route.



PEARL VALLEY GOLF

This week's golf tip from Pearl Valley Golf Academy focuses on a key fundamental - posture. Posture is very important because it helps our bodies perform the correct movements in the golf swing and also aids in maintaining good balance while swinging the golf club. When we overlook posture, it can create many faults in our swing.

Here's a simple way to find the correct posture at address: without a club in your hand, flex your knees, bend slightly from the waist, and then let your arms drop down naturally. Clap your hands together, and you'll be in proper address posture. It's as simple as that!

Check out this great example of the correct posture at address. Notice the flexion in the knees, the slight bend from the waist, and the hanging of the arms.



To ensure you're doing it correctly, stand in front of a mirror and compare your natural posture to the image above.
