Key Insights from the Security Townhall Meeting

On 6 March 2025, residents gathered for an insightful Security Townhall Meeting, where industry leaders shared key security updates and showcased advanced security measures that safeguard our Estate.

Riaan Crafford, Chairperson of the Security Committee, outlined the 2025 focus on proactive security. Marius Herselman, Head of Risk and Security, presented key 2024 statistics, while Costa Diavastos, CEO of Bidvest Protea Coin, highlighted the company's role in strengthening security. Waal de Waal, COO of Bidvest Protea Coin, demonstrated cutting-edge technologies and tactical response capabilities in action.

The event concluded with a live demonstration, including helicopter and drone flyovers, K9 narcotics detection and real-time surveillance, offering residents a glimpse into the future of Estate protection. All demonstrations were approved by the Civil Aviation Authority and HOAs.

UPDATE: WATER PRESSURE ON THE ESTATE

Since Drakenstein Municipality repaired a leak in their mainline infrastructure, stones and grit have been accumulating in the water meter strainer, restricting the flow of water into the Estate. Despite multiple efforts by Drakenstein to flush the lines and clear the debris, the issue remains unresolved.

Estate management is still working closely with Drakenstein's senior water management team to support them in finding a solution. In the meantime, residents should unfortunately expect fluctuating water pressure and occasional interruptions.

In respect of potential measures to ensure sustainability of sufficient water supply within the Estate, the HOA has appointed engineers to evaluate the impact of increased water demand on the infrastructure resulting from the incorporation of The Acres and the extent of household irrigation measured throughout the Estate.

Further information will be shared with residents as soon as possible.

REMINDER: PEARL VALLEY BIKE TRAILS CLOSED

The pump track in The Acres remains closed for safety reasons. The Acres Developer has committed to repairing and reinstating the track as part of its obligations to complete the landscaping of the 30m heritage buffer area between the boundary fence and the residential erven. Once the work is completed, the area will be formally handed over to the HOA and we will then assume responsibility for ongoing maintenance.

Riders should also please note that the bike trail which ran from the end of Mount Juliet Avenue through the upper sections of Watervliet Farm has also been closed. The HOA is currently in discussions with the landowners and a trail builder with regards to access rights and potential trail routes. Further information will be shared in this regard as soon as possible.

Breaking Par Series - 9 March 2025

The first Breaking Par Series event took place this past weekend. The Breaking Par Series is designed to challenge young golfers with a series of 9-hole courses, all set at par 36, where every hole is a par 4. The courses vary in distance, starting from the shortest at 25 meters and moving all the way back to the most challenging at 175 meters.

Juniors begin on the White course (25 meters) and must break par to move to the next level. As they progress, they advance through the colour-coded courses: Orange (50m), Purple (75m), Pink (100m), Blue (125m), Lime (150m), and finally, Grey (175m). Once they complete all levels, juniors enter the Par 27 series, where they start on the 25-meter course again, but with the added challenge of playing all holes as par 3s.

• Pink Course (100m):

Wiehan advances to the Blue course.

- Blue Course (125m): 1st Place: Sergio Gomes Score: 37
- Lime Course (150m): Marko Swart Score: 42

Grey Course (175m): 1st Place: Fred Wolseley Brinton – Score: 35

Congratulations to Fred, who now moves on to the Par 27 series, starting again on the White course with all holes set to par 3.

The next event will take place on Sunday 30 March, and we can't wait to see how these young golfers continue to progress. Good luck to all participants, and remember, it's not just about the scores but the skills and experience gained along the way. Keep practising, and we'll see you on the course!

CS BIOKINETICISTS AT PEARL VALLEY GYM



AN ACL (ANTERIOR CRUCIATE LIGAMENT) INJURY IS A SPRAIN OR TEAR OF THE LIGAMENT THAT STABILIZES THE KNEE. IT COMMONLY OCCURS DURING SPORTS INVOLVING SUDDEN STOPS, CHANGES IN DIRECTION, OR JUMPING.

Causes



- Sudden pivoting or cutting movements
- · Landing incorrectly from a jump
- · Direct impact to the knee
- Rapid deceleration while running

SYMPTOMS

- A "popping" sound at the time of injury
- Swelling & pain within hours
- · Instability or knee "giving way"
- · Loss of full range of motion

Types:

Grade 1: Mild sprain, ligament is stretched but intact

Grade 2: Partial tear, ligament is loosened

Grade 3: Complete tear, knee becomes unstable
