



USE OF GENERATORS

With the continued high levels of loadshedding, the HOA would like to draw attention to the fact that approval from the Estate Manager is required prior the installation of any generator, whether permanently fitted or portable.

- The requirements for approval are detailed in section 10.6 of the Estate Rules.
- Only Ultra Silent Generators running at a maximum of 1500 revolutions per minute with a maximum sound pressure level of 51 dB are allowed.
- Generators may not be used between the hours of 23:00 and 06:00, regardless of the stage of loadshedding.

The HOA is responsible for maintaining a total of 10 lakes and dams, covering a sizeable area of the Estate. These water bodies are complex ecosystems, sustaining a wide variety of fauna and flora, and are subject to various seasonal changes as temperatures and rainfall fluctuate during the year. They are also essential components of our estate irrigation and storm water management systems. As such, they require very careful management, with an emphasis on sustainable, environmentally sound, long-term strategies, rather than "quick fixes".

Estate management is currently engaging with the HOA's appointed environmental consultants to review our management practices and ensure that we continue to adapt and improve wherever possible.

In order to perform at your optimum level, you would have to have a basic exercise routine. When exercising, focus on strengthening the core muscles and strengthening leg muscles. Remember to have light stretching session in the morning and the evening to loosen up the muscles.

Don't forget to warm up on the range before you start hitting balls. Warm-ups include rotational movements of the Upper body and lower body also wrists and ankles.

Once you have completed your warmup session you can start hitting balls with a short iron making small swings to start with, eventually leading up to a full swing. When performing the full swing, DON'T FORGET TO TURN!


