IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR PEARL VALLEY HOMEOWNERS AND RESIDENTS:

PEARL VALLEY GOLF

Common Mistakes Golfers Often Make:

1. Confusing Comfort with Correct:

To improve your golf game and reduce your handicap, it's essential to welcome necessary changes and accept that adjustments may not always feel immediately comfortable. Something uncomfortable in the short term can significantly enhance your performance in the long run.

2. Being Too Aggressive on Your First Putt:

A notable difference between high and low-handicap golfers lies in the frequency of three putts per round. Higher handicap golfers often attempt to hole out on long-distance putts, resulting in overshooting the hole. To minimise the number of putts per round, focus on speed control for lengthier putts. Rather than aiming to hole out on longer putts, opt for the tap-in. Emphasise speed over the line on longer putts. It might not be glamorous, but it will save you a few strokes every time.

3. Attempting the Hero Shot:

When you find yourself in the fairway with a substantial distance to cover, avoid always reaching for your longest club (e.g., a 3-wood for many). While you might gain some distance if you hit it well, the risk of bigger miss-hits increases. Instead, build confidence and momentum with a club you can consistently handle - such as a 7-iron. Once you succeed with this choice and are confident in keeping the ball in play, then consider transitioning to your longer fairway woods.

4. Poor Balance:

Expanding on the previous point: maintaining balance before, during, and after your swing is crucial for achieving solid contact. Even if you execute a technically sound swing, losing balance along the way could turn a potentially great shot into a miss. A good habit is to hold your finish until the ball comes to a stop.

5. Inconsistent Setup Routine:

While hand-eye coordination is valuable, it's not the sole factor contributing to successful contact for skilled golfers. Haphazardly positioning your feet and adjusting based on comfort can result in different postures for various clubs, making consistent contact nearly impossible. Superior golfers adhere to a consistent setup routine and order, enabling them to adopt an athletic, balanced golf posture, which, in turn, facilitates consistent contact.




