

INVESTIGATION INTO HIGH WATER BILLS

The HOA's investigation into complaints regarding unusually high water bills is continuing.

Each individual case is being carefully reviewed and feedback given directly to the residents.

At this stage, it is too early to draw any definitive conclusions but, whilst the work is ongoing, we do want to encourage residents who are not yet doing so to use the Voltano ClientApp to monitor their water consumption directly. The ClientApp is a very useful tool which enables users to track water consumption on a daily and monthly basis. For hourly readings, residents are advised to contact Voltano directy.

JACK NICKLAUS BOULEVARD IRRIGATION

Residents may sometimes notice irrigation water leaks along the Jack Nicklaus Boulevard and be concerned about possible water losses. Estate Management would like to share the following relevant information in this regard.

Jack Nicklaus Boulevard is approximately 1.2 km long, with 10 lines of irrigation piping and multiple connections, amounting to about 12 km of pipes in total, with 2 000 drip irrigation fittings. The entire irrigation system is computerised, with 26 stations, each station running for 60 minutes at a time.

All the water used is irrigation water, not potable water, drawn from the Estate's dams which are supplied by rainwater, ground water and river water. Any run-off water that enters the storm water drains is ultimately returned to the Estate's dams.

Baboons, mice, and squirrels are a constant nuisance along the Boulevard, causing leaks and breakages in the irrigation pipes. Occasionally, more severe damage is caused by cars being parked on the verges.

HOA staff and Security staff monitor the road regularly. Where leaks or pipe bursts are reported during normal working hours they are generally attended to by the Maintenance team within an hour. After hours, maintenance staff are called out in severe cases, such as a valve becoming stuck in the open position and not automatically shutting off at the end of a 60-minute cycle.

We appeal to residents who notice faults or leaks to report them immediately to info@pvhoa.co.za or the Security Control Room on 021 867 1201 and to please refrain from trying to fix a leak or a burst pipe themselves – there are many snakes in the area!

POLLARDING OF POPLAR TREES

The HOA is pleased to share that the pollarding of the poplar trees between Bear Creek Boulevard and The Acres has been successfully completed. This project involved the pruning of more than 250 poplar trees. Here is some interesting information about the process and its benefits.

What is pollarding?

Pollarding is a pruning technique used to control the growth of trees, typically employed once a tree reaches the desired height in order to prevent it from growing any taller and encourage more density at lower levels.


The benefits of tree pollarding include:

Improving the health of the tree: Pollarding not only helps achieve the desired shape, but also removes dead or diseased branches that can drain the tree's resources and harm its health. Enhancing exposure to sunlight: Thick, dense branches can make the lower parts of the tree susceptible to decay. Pollarding removes excess branches and allows sunlight to reach lower levels.

Detecting disease: Pollarding allows for an assessment of the tree's health, as diseases or decay become evident during the process.

Minimizing potential damage: Pollarding reduces the risk of large branches encroaching on homes or parked vehicles, which is especially important in exposed areas or if the tree overhangs a public footpath or road.

PEARL VALLEY GOLF

The Golf team's tip for this week focuses on greenside bunkers. Many golfers fear these bunkers and struggle to get the ball out, often hitting too many shots inside the bunker or over-hitting the green by thinning the ball out of the sand. These inconsistencies usually result from having the wrong setup and technique. Golfers often set up to a bunker shot like they would for a chip shot, with their feet too close together, a short choppy swing, and a square clubface.

To help you conquer your fears and improve your bunker play, here are some easy steps to follow:

- 1. The setup wide width with feet. Ball position left of centre in stance. Align your body left of the target and aim the clubface toward the target.
- 2. Open the clubface to add more loft but also to utilize the bounce of the sand/lob wedge (to avoid digging).
- 3. The clubface should point back at you at the end of the back-swing and at the end of the through-swing.
- 4. Swing length almost full swing.

Always remember, the bunker shot is the easiest shot of them all! It's the only shot in golf where you do not have to hit the ball 😉


