PEARL VALLEY GOLF ACADEMY

Leave the Chicken Wings for KFC

"Chicken Winging" is a term used to describe the appearance of the lead arm in players/golfers who bend their lead elbow (target side) and cup their lead wrist (target side) through impact. The lead arm resembles the wing of a chicken, hence the name.

This is common among players with an "Over-the-Top" golf swing, which is created by a loss of body connection. Typically, golfers experience excessive breakdown of the upper body through impact, caused by poor lower body movement. When the lower body fails to generate efficient speed or transfer that speed to the upper body, the arms and hands compensate for this loss. Moreover, if the lower body doesn't initiate the downswing sequence, the swing path can become steep or "over-the-top". Loss of the external rotation in the lead shoulder can also cause Chicken Winging. External rotation is required for the lead arm to release and rotate normally through impact.

Here are a few drills to help overcome the Chicken Wing:

1. You can use any flat object such as a tennis racquet, ping pong racquet, plate, or book. Place it in your lead hand, ensuring the lead arm is extended and the object is perpendicular to the target line, resembling the clubface's position. Take a half-backswing, feeling a slight internal rotation of the lead arm and wrist. Then, perform the downswing to the impact position, ensuring that the lead arm and wrist are extended, and the flat object is once again perpendicular to the target. The post-impact movement should resemble an extended lead arm and wrist position with external rotation of the arm, wrist, and shoulder joint.



2. Place a round object, such as a small ball or balloon, between your arms. Grab a club, take your grip, and perform a golf swing while keeping the ball between your arms. This exercise will assist in maintaining the correct arm structure throughout the golf swing.






