PEARL VALLEY GOLF ACADEMY

Shorting out your short game:

This week's short tip the Pearl Valley Golf Academy will be focusing on the "chip shot" vs the "lob shot"

We all know that sometimes these short game shots can be daunting and most of the time opt for taking the putter out of the bag, sometimes from quite a distance away from the green. These two short game shots should not be so difficult to execute if the necessary time is allocated practising them at the short game practice green at your club or practice facility.

The distinct difference between the two is the ball flight characteristics. The CHIP has a much lower ball flight to the LOB. So, when do we play these two shot types on the course?

These two shots are normally performed around the green. The CHIP would be performed when just off the green and there is lots of space (green) between the player and the hole. This is the easier of the two because it is like a putt. The journey of the ball to the hole initially takes off and spends a short while in flight then rolls out to the hole. The LOB requires a higher ball flight so, this shot would be used over green side slopes/hills or green side bunkers. This shot is the scariest of the two. Golfers normally fear to chunk (hitting it fat) or thinning it over the green.

How to play these two shot types:

The CHIP: Set up with a narrower base/stance (feet closer together) and add more pressure on the lead foot than the trail foot. Ratio 60/40%. NB do not move pressure onto the back foot when taking a back swing. Ball position favouring trail foot so, just right of centre. The swing length is shorter. The body parts involved in performing the chip swing are mostly the shoulders and arms. Arms are long in length forming a triangular shape with arms and shoulders. Move the triangle back and forward with no wrist angles in the swing. Preferred club for the chip, pitching wedge/gap wedge, 9 iron.

The LOB: Setup with a wider base/stance (feet wider apart) and keep pressure on the lead foot (foot closest to target). Ball position favouring lead foot so, just left of centre. The swing length is wider and longer. Body parts involved in performing the lob is still predominantly the shoulders and arms (moving the triangle) but with the longer swing length wrist will gradually get involved in the lob swing but to a minimum. Preferred club for the lob, lob wedge/sand wedge.

The compost site on Watervliet Farm, near to the Boma, is exclusively for green waste and we appeal to residents not to use the area as a general dump site for recycling materials or general waste. If plastic bags are used to transport garden waste, the bags must be emptied at the site and then removed. All recyclables should be deposited in the designated bins near the Pearl Valley Main Gate.

In the event where large tree trunks and branches have been cut, it is the resident's responsibility to have it removed from the Estate. No refuse, garden soil, or rubble may be dumped on vacant stands, as per Estate Rule no. 14.2.

In accordance with the Estate Rules, the HOA requests all homeowners' cooperation in the correct disposal of waste.
