

UPDATE ON INVESTIGATION INTO HIGH WATER BILLS

The HOA's investigation into complaints regarding unusually high water bills is continuing.

We are investigating every query received, checking consumption recorded per the Voltano information system by physically inspecting the meters, and also analysing the consumption recorded for trends and patterns.

To date, we have not found any instances where air trapped in the mainlines caused meters to erroneously record water consumption. Furthermore, no evidence has been found to indicate that water meters are not functioning correctly or that there are errors in the data uploaded from the meters to the Voltano system.

The HOA's billing processes have also been checked and we have confirmed that the Drakenstein Water Tariffs are being correctly applied.

We have found one instance so far where the meter reading reflected on the homeowner's accounts differed from the actual water meter reading. This was due to a manual input error which has been corrected and the account of the owner has been credited.

All other queries however are indicating a consistent pattern linked to the use of irrigation systems, prevalent during the hot summer months in Paarl.

Many people are not aware of the amount of water that an average domestic irrigation system uses:

- Typically, a standard irrigation system delivers a water flow rate of about 45 litres per minute, or 2 700 litres per hour.
- Using an example of a garden that has 10 stations, running at 10 minutes per station per day, it follows that:
 - 1. Total water consumption of only the irrigation system would amount to 45 x 10 x 10 = 4 500 litres per day.
 - 2. Running this cycle every day for a 30-day month would equate to 135 000 litres of water consumed, only on the garden.
 - 3. According to the prevailing Drakenstein Water Tariffs, this alone would result in a bill of R9 730.
 - 4. Running this same cycle twice a day would however result in a bill of R23 334 (excluding all other household consumption).
- If for any reason (e.g. loadshedding throwing the system out of its normal timing cycles) an irrigation system runs for longer than intended, it could disperse over 10 000 litres in less than 4 hours.

We wish to thank those residents who have taken the opportunity to get acquainted with the Voltano Client App, or are using other private apps linked to their irrigation systems, in order to actively monitor their water consumption themselves. We recognise that the Voltano "App" is essentially a website link and are aware that there can be some delays in data being uploaded due to loadshedding as the system depends on standard cellular signals. However, the "App" is

still a very useful tool for residents wanting to track their water consumption on a daily and monthly basis.

Voltano have informed us that they are actively working on ways to minimize delays and ensure that data available on the "App" is as up to date as possible. They are also looking into possible enhancements, such as an option for homeowners to set custom alert levels (e.g. to receive a notice when consumption reaches a specified level in a month).

We will provide further detailed feedback once all queries have been concluded.

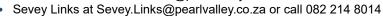
